WHEREAS, Registered Apprenticeship programs are uniquely able to meet the changing demands of the Ohio economy and provide a path for all qualified individuals – including women, youth, people of color, rural communities, justice-involved individuals, and individuals with disabilities – to become apprentices and contribute to America's industries; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio recognizes that Registered Apprenticeship, a proven and industry-driven training model, is a key strategy to improving job quality and creating access to good-paying, family-sustaining jobs for all, starting with youth and young adults, while addressing some of our nation's pressing workforce challenges such as rebuilding our country's infrastructure, addressing critical supply chain demands, supporting a clean energy workforce, modernizing our cybersecurity response, and responding to care economy issues;
