The Local\Regional geographic scope of the project will be carried out in the	

counties of Jessamine, Lawrence, Lincoln, and Magoffin counties in Kentucky. The overall **scope** of **IMPACT** is to establish and increase partnerships that commit to expanding previously developed pre-apprenticeship programs which will lead to developing and expanding Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) enrollment for our “hard to serve” high school and adult learners (ages 16-24). Project **IMPACT** aims to direct apprenticeships toward high-growth industries by working with our targeted schools to prepare students for in-demand fields, while providing them with the employability skills to meet the current workforce needs.
