Registered Apprenticeship Technical Assistance Centers (RA TA Centers)

Partnering with the U.S. Department of Labor's (USDOL) Office of Apprenticeship (OA), Registered Apprenticeship Technical Assistance (RA TA) Centers serve as resources to apprenticeship stakeholders and other interested customers. To support Registered Apprenticeship program expansion and modernization, the RA TA Centers will provide technical assistance (TA) services on a national level in critical areas identified below to boost the Registered Apprenticeship system.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE RA TA CENTERS?

The RA TA Centers of Excellence are designated entities that provide technical expertise and services on a national scale to key Registered Apprenticeship program stakeholders and customers to accelerate and support Registered Apprenticeship program expansion. These RA TA Centers support three key areas (outlined below) and provide technical assistance on a national scale to the Registered Apprenticeship community, which increases the effectiveness of appropriated federal funding used for the expansion of Registered Apprenticeship programs across the nation.

WHAT SERVICES WILL THE RA TA CENTERS PROVIDE?

The RA TA Centers develop best practices, success stories, toolkits, and written resources to assist Registered Apprenticeship stakeholders and customers. The RA TA Centers deliver comprehensive technical assistance to the Registered Apprenticeship community on a national scale to foster increased participation of all Americans being served in Registered Apprenticeship programs. The RA TA Centers support national goals including the transparency, usability, and portability of Registered Apprenticeship standards; the overall expansion and modernization of Registered Apprenticeship programs; system alignment of Registered Apprenticeship programs and other Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funded programs; and data integrity.

WHAT ROLES DO THE RA TA CENTERS PLAY IN REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP?

Data and Performance and Best Practices RA TA Center - The Council for State Governments (CSG). Improves Registered Apprenticeship program data alignment and expansion. This RA TA Center aims to:

Provide training, support, and sustainability planning to Registered Apprenticeship programs and states by using means such as webinars, white papers, and research materials to improve data collection and data alignment.





- Leverage relationships with stakeholders to continuously improve general alignment and integration with workforce programs through peerto-peer trainings and business process analysis and intelligence.
- Enhance partnerships with workforce development stakeholders though engagement and strategic planning.

STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS AND SYSTEM ALIGNMENT RA TA CENTER – SAFAL PARTNERS

Accelerates national scaling of apprenticeship by building and sustaining partnerships that support system alignment with the nation's workforce and education systems. This RA TA Center aims to:

- Increase understanding about Registered Apprenticeship in the workforce system, leading to doubled workforce system participation in Registered Apprenticeship programs.
- Provide workforce system training that supports an integrated service delivery approach and development of resources to increase leveraging of the WIOA and other federal funding across workforce programs for apprenticeship.
- Increase employer, education and training provider, intermediary, and workforce system partnerships through development and dissemination of national technical assistance materials, web-based training, and 'deep dive' assistance to key stakeholders in a minimum of five states.
- Collect feedback and promising practices from practitioners and stakeholders in the field to inform new federal and state-level policy recommendations focused on Registered Apprenticeship program acceleration and workforce/education alignment.

OCCUPATIONS AND STANDARDS

RA TA CENTER - URBAN INSTITUTE

Builds a gold-standard occupational skills infrastructure that increases the transparency, portability, quality, usability, and scalability of the Registered Apprenticeship system. This RA TA Center aims to:

- Create a comprehensive and modernized online compendium of standards for the Registered Apprenticeship system that integrates those from the federal and state systems.
- Provide training and technical assistance to Registered Apprenticeship program sponsors to help them use <u>National Occupational Frameworks</u> to develop programs.
- Promote methodologies and best practices to ensure a sustainable, high-quality Registered Apprenticeship system.
