BACKGROUND: OATELS, Dennis Underwood, ATR, on behalf of the Indiana Air National Guard, initiated this apprenticeability request for ninety-two (92) occupations used by the Indiana Air National Guard. The occupations were cross referenced by job description, RAIS Code, O*Net/SOC Code and the list of Apprenticeable Occupations. Of the ninety-two (92) occupations, seventy-one (71) were classified as currently Apprenticeable and twenty-one (21) as new Apprenticeable occupations.
