PURPOSE: To transmit to the Office of Apprenticeship Training, Employer and Labor Services (OATELS), Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training (BAT) Staff National Guideline Standards of Apprenticeship developed by Southeastern Container Corporation with technical assistance provided by OATELS National Office.

BACKGROUND: OATELS Administrator Anthony Swoope adopted and approved the attached National Guideline Standards as part of the National Apprenticeship System on July 6, 2005. They are a model for developing local apprenticeship programs registered with the BAT or State Apprenticeship Agency/Councils for Maintenance Mechanic.

There should be very little deviation from the Apprenticeship Standards (except for wages and the journey worker rate) when they are developed locally by BAT Staff.
