**PURPOSE:** To inform the Office of Apprenticeship Training, Employer and Labor Services (OATELS), Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training Staff (BAT) Staff of a new apprenticeable occupation:

Air Traffic Controller (Military Only)

 O\*NET Code: 53-2021.00  
 Training Term: 2,500 hours  
 Type of Training: Competency – based

**BACKGROUND:** Dennis Underwood, ATR, on behalf of the Indiana Air National Guard initiated the apprenticeability request for this occupation.

The “Air Traffic Controller” is an essential occupation to the Air National Guard and the U.S. Air Force. Military personnel that complete this apprenticeship program and meet the requirement for AFSC 1C1X1 are exempt from the FAA school, when applying for civilian positions.

Attached is a PDF file containing the Air Traffic Controller, U.S. Air Force AFSC 1C1X1, Career Field Education and Training Plan (CFETP), which includes the work process schedule and related instruction outline.
