**BACKGROUND:** The occupation Transit Rail Vehicle Maintenance Technician was submitted by Mr. Mark Dysart on behalf of the Transportation Learning Center, for apprenticeability determination for a revision to the title, type of training and the term.

The revision of Transit Rail Vehicle Maintenance Technician has changed the type of training from timebased to hybrid. The time-based approach was 8,000 OJL hours; the hybrid approach has a minimum of 5,400 of OJL hours.

**<u>ACTION</u>**: The OA staff should familiarize themselves with this bulletin and the attached Work Process Schedule and Related Instruction Outline, as a source for developing apprenticeship standards and/or providing technical assistance.
