**PURPOSE:** To inform the Office of Apprenticeship (OA) and the State Apprenticeship Agencies (SAA) staff, Registered Apprenticeship Program Sponsors and other Registered Apprenticeship Partners of the approval of new National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards for the Department of Treasury, United States Mint.

**BACKGROUND:** These National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards submitted by Regional Executive Assistant Robert Laudeman, on behalf of the Department of Treasury, United States Mint, was approved by the OA Administrator on July 20, 2010. These National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards are a model for developing local apprenticeship programs registered with OA or a SAA for the occupation Die Manufacturer (existing title: Tool and Die Maker) for the following: Department of Treasury, United States Mint locations, Philadelphia, PA and Denver, CO.
